

Fixed Bridge




Teeth adjacent to the missing tooth are prepared to support three connected crowns.

Dental Implant



A dental implant is placed directly into the bone. A crown is attached to the implant, leaving the adjacent teeth intact while preserving the bone of the jaw.

Implant Placement



A dental implant is designed to replace the root of a missing tooth. Once placed in the jaw, this critical understructure serves as the foundation on which to erect a standalone replacement tooth.

Final Restoration
