


There are many choices of materials to use for creating your custom designed partial denture. Your dentist will determine your unique needs through an oral examination and present your options. Your product choices may include some of the following:

Flipper

Flippers are temporary, lightweight appliances for patients with only a few missing teeth.



Thermoplastic Flexible Partial

In place of acrylic, this durable tissue-colored thermoplastic can be used with or without all available metals to improve the look and feel of your partial denture.



Partial Fabricated Through Selective Laser Melting (SLM)

A high-powered laser fuses metal layer by layer to create a sturdy framework for your partial to ensure long-term reliability.



3D-Printed Flexible Partial

This digitally designed solution offers maximum flexibility and comfort for all-day wear.



Partial with Crowns

When crowns and a partial are needed, your dentist may suggest a partial that connects to your crowns for a comfortable, natural look.



To improve the look and durability of your new partial denture, ask your dentist about premium denture teeth.

WHAT IS INVOLVED

Getting a new partial can be simple and painless. Typically, no drilling of your teeth is needed. Your dentist will determine your unique dental needs in order to give you a comfortable partial.

Follow your dentist's care and cleaning instructions to keep your new appliance clean and looking great.

- 1 First, your dentist will perform an oral exam to determine the right partial for you.



- 2 Next, your dentist takes impressions and sends them to the lab to start your appliance. Adjustments may follow.



- 3 At your final appointment, your new partial is delivered, along with care tips for long-lasting wear.
