


PATIENT HOME CARE INSTRUCTIONS

FOR USE WITH YOUR PARTIAL DENTURE






Remove partial every night to give your gums the chance to rest.



Brush Daily. Remove partial. Rinse to remove loose food or debris, then brush outside of the mouth with cold tap water and an extra-soft toothbrush.



Soak partial in cold tap water at least twice per week. Add Polident® or Efferdent® cleansing tablets for cleaning (follow manufacturer instructions).



Do NOT use toothpaste, hydrogen peroxide, baking powder, mouthwash (or other forms of alcohol), bleach, boiling water or sodium hydroxide to clean or remove stains.



Warm-water reset: You may soak your partial in warm water to help it regain its shape if it feels slightly distorted. Use only warm—not hot—water.



Maintain health of remaining teeth. See your dentist annually. If your partial breaks, chips, cracks, stains or becomes loose, contact your dentist immediately.

ADDITIONAL TIPS

- **Do NOT modify the partial denture yourself.** Doing so can damage it beyond repair, causing fit and function issues. Self-service of your partial is evident to your dentist and will instantly void any expressed warranty.
- **Brush any remaining natural teeth twice a day** and before reinserting your partial denture.
